It was encouraging to have similar numbers return this year to participate, with 137 entries and 92 players. Both juniors and adults came to test their skills, and 21 events were completed. Other interesting features:

JUNIOR CLASSIC

This annual tournament was relatively successful, with some 70 local juniors contesting the 13 events. The weather made it enjoyable for the players and the support crew! Although participant numbers were down, over 105 matches were scheduled during the Labour Day weekend, and Round-robin format was used to give players in an opportunity to mix and test their skills when entries were limited. Star attraction was the 10 & Under Boys "green ball" round robin, and the winner medallions were very popular.



Overall, the tournament ran well, and there were many favourable comments from players and parents. The major disappointment was the low participation by girls — only two events had sufficient entries, in contrast to 11 boys' events being contested. This apparently is not unusual currently with competitive events, and is a trend we all need to work on changing for the better.

A regular band of court managers and canteen assistants helped with the success of the tournament, in support of organizers Carole Houston, Julie Limbach, Maria Keys and Danni Skiba. Many thanks to Kevin Dalach, Alan Frigerio, Liz Bradley, Sam Houston, Russell Grigg & Chris Belcher – your "maintenance fee" activity is now recorded.



COURT CARE & BOOKINGS

With Night Comp in full swing, and Pennant about to start, tennis is very popular, and court availability is quite limited, especially from 5.00pm weekdays, and generally on the weekend. Don't just arrive & hope!!

You MUST book a court if you wish to play, & check at the office before going on court. You MUST also pay a Visitor's Fee before playing if you invite a friend to have a hit.

The dry, windy weather is making our courts quite dry and dusty too – they need extra care!!

Watering from fence to fence before you play is very important — and you should water again at least every 30 minutes. We also request that the court surface is sprinkled before bagging the court — that helps stop the en tous cas from blowing away.

Please read the NOTICE on the fence near the gates – it details court care requirements.
