We are going well with our aim of improving on last year's total membership for the year! Events:

Members would be aware that we recently hosted a major tournament run by Tennis Australia – it was the Victorian Junior Claycourt International, which is part of the ITF Junior World Circuit. An 18/u event, it ran 13-19 April, and featured some of Australia's brightest up-and-coming 13-16 year-olds. We provided canteen services (with thanks to our volunteers!) and helped the organisers with matches through some very trying weather conditions. Our coaches were very supportive too – sharing court availability and checking schedule progress.

The event was very successful – Tennis Australia and contestants were quite complimentary about our facilities, and the club benefited significantly from the high profile, as well as the canteen takings and the court hire. It also gave us the impetus to check our courts over for broken/chipped lines and build-up of en tout cas; as well as purchasing some additional courtside seats (made from recycled material).

This is a new opportunity to keep up your skills in between regular night competition seasons. You can enter as an individual or with a team (only need 2 players for each match - 16YO+);


- Matches will be scheduled on Tuesday evenings at the club 7.00 to 8.30pm
