- general coaching try-outs and sausage sizzle;



#### WE NOW HAVE THE BOOK-A-COURT SYSTEM IN OPERATION TOO

Please register/activate your account in response to the recent invitation email from Carole. Use the web based system for bookings between 7.00am – 4.30pm Monday-Friday

Otherwise, phone the office - 9380 1259 – as usual.

You MUST book a court if you wish to play, & check at the office before going on court. You MUST also pay a Visitor's Fee before playing if you invite a friend to have a hit.

The warmer, windy weather is making our courts quite dry and dusty too – they need extra care!!

Watering from fence to fence before you play is very important – and you should water again at least every 30 minutes. We also request that the court surface is sprinkled before bagging the court – that helps stop the en tous cas from blowing away.
