

#### **COURT CARE**

With the persistent winds, and return of some warmer weather, our courts are very dry and thirsty; We need assistance from all players to ensure our courts are well maintained;

You **MUST** water well before play – from fence to fence (& not just between the lines);

Watering should also be done after each set or half-hour of hitting;

Please sprinkle before bagging after play as well; that settles the dust and keeps the en tout cas stable If the courts do not get enough water, the playing area will break up and holes will appear.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

Our first four month's period has finished, and it's encouraging to see that we have 344 members returning for 2014/15. That's a 71% return rate, which is similar to the previous year, and reasonably positive. We have also attracted 57 new members, and now have a total of 411 (incl. Honorary).

However, another 90 are needed to get back to our long-term average of 500!! Please help!! Do your best to convince visitors to join up!! We have quite a few member benefits on offer!! And our fees are very reasonable in comparison with neighbouring clubs!!

# AGM Report

Our 2013/14 Annual General Meeting was held Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> September, with all members invited to come along. Attendance was very disappointing – only 17 members signed in! and that was after we interrupted some players on-court to join the AGM to make a quorum!! WHERE WERE YOU???

These were some of the main points reported:



- \* a positive Net Trading result of \$44,344, providing some \$172,666 in funds for on-going activities;
- \* membership levels dropped by 6%, going below 500 for the first time in 18 years;
- \* strong competition results, with 84 teams participating across seasons, and 6 premierships won;
- \* Popular member benefits (Wine Offer & Australian Open ticketing), plus positive Special Events;
- \* Member Services Manager appointed to reinvigorate social tennis & increase patronage.
